Dwight Raby

Dwight grew up in upstate New York (WAY upstate NY - basically Canada) and first picked up a guitar in college just to get girls. Upon enrolling in graduate school at Emory University, he quickly immersed himself in the burgeoning Atlanta music scene with solo acoustic performances at places like Eddie's Attic, Smith's Olde Bar, and Park Bench. He stayed at Emory, coaching cross country for a time and then working in the College Office, but maintained his musical endeavors throughout. After stints as lead vocalist for the local blues band Totally Savage and as frontman for the short-lived funk/soul quintet kool'haus, he was noticed by a local promoter and began playing three shows a week all over the Atlanta area. Dwight has also played, both as a solo act and with his band, in Destin, FL, St. Simon's Island, GA, Greenville, SC, Knoxville, TN, Chattanooga, TN and Burlington, VT.

Jeff Beach

Jeff Beach is a professional drummer working in the music scene all over the Southeastern United States. Currently, Jeff is living and working in Atlanta, and is quickly becoming a first call for live performance, recording sessions, and educational clinics all over the country. A graduate and former instructor of the Atlanta Institute of Music, Jeff has had the opportunity to share the stage with acts such as Maroon 5, The Doobie Bros.
